

Registration

There are 18 camper spots available for this camp, with ONLY 6 spots guaranteed to Green County. These spots will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis, so register early.

STEP 1—FIND THE EVENT IN 4HONLINE: Log into your 4HOnline family account and look at your member list. Scroll to the bottom and find the section titled “Register A Member In An Event”. Select “**2017 Green County 4-H Adventure Camp (Gr. 7-8).**” A series of boxes will appear at the bottom of the screen. Click “Register”.

STEP 2—REGISTER FOR THE EVENT: On the next screen you will be asked for specific information related to the event (*i.e. t-shirt size, possible roommate preference, bus pick-up location, food allergies and other possible accommodation requests*) Verify your choices and click “Check Out .”

STEP 3—PAYMENT: On the Payment screen, the only selection is County/Club 4-H Check. Click on the “Select Payment Method” button. On the Confirm screen, check the box agreeing to the Pay By Computer Terms and Conditions. Click the “Confirm Order” button. Make checks payable to the **Green County 4-H Adult Leaders**. Green/Iowa/Lafayette County 4-H Camp will be offering 18 youth in 7th-8th grade, as of the 2016-2017 school year, the opportunity to experience 4-H Adventure Camp at Upham Woods.

This year's camp will strongly focus on experiencing ADVENTURE, TEAMWORK, and NATURE.

- Do you like being active outdoors and learning about your environment?

This camp is sure to EXCITE and ENGAGE any youth who comes ready to actively participate with other youth in exploring our great outdoors!

2017 4-H Adventure Camp

(7th-8th grade, as of the 2016-2017 school year)
June 19-21, 2017

At adventure camp you will enjoy a variety of fun camp activities planned by Adventure Camp's youth and adult staff.

Adventure: You will take a half day trip around Blackhawk Island, which will include canoeing, and possibly kayaking, on the Wisconsin River. During the camp, you will also do some hiking on uneven terrain and swimming. There is a required swim test given at camp before campers can participate in any water activities. A lifeguard is present during all water activities.

Teamwork: Right away the first day, you will be participating in games and activities to help you get to know and work with youth from across the three counties. You will get to challenge your ability to work well in teams throughout camp, whether on the low ropes challenge course, cooking group dinner on the camp stove or paddling on the Wisconsin River.

Nature: You will experience the many natural wonders in and around camp, including the Upper Dells sandstone cliffs and lush, green forests, the Wisconsin River, and Blackhawk Island (a state designated Nature Area). You will actively explore this natural world and have the opportunity to reflect on your role in preserving our environment for future generations.

As part of nature focus, you may have opportunities to do nature related art projects or go on a night hike with adult supervision.

Campfires: Finally, no 4-H Camp would be complete without enjoying nightly campfires, where you will be able to celebrate with music and entertainment. An added bonus of this small camp will be the opportunity to make delicious, fun snacks over the campfire.

Upham Woods 4-H Camp is an outdoor learning center located along the banks of the beautiful Wisconsin River. The camp is owned and operated by the Wisconsin 4-H program, and offers cabins, a dining hall, and numerous areas for indoor and outdoor learning.

For Adventure Camp, campers and staff will be staying in tents in a wooded area behind the Nature Center. Campers will stay in groups of 2-3 campers of the same gender per tent. Tent are provided by the camp. Bathroom facilities will be available in the nature center. The group will also have use of a bath house, with individual showers; though not located near the tent area.

Adventure campers will utilize the dining hall for breakfasts, while preparing their lunch and dinner meals at their campsite. All campers are served plentiful, nutritious, family style meals. A nature building and multiple meeting rooms are available for educational programs or in the case of inclement weather.

An adult volunteer trained in first aid and CPR will be on staff and will handle health and safety needs, and administer medications for youth under the age of 14. The Dells-Delton EMS Squad is ready to handle any emergencies. All campers are provided accident insurance.

The camp will be overseen by Ellen Andrews, the Green County 4-H Youth Development Educator. The camp staff will consist of 2 adult volunteers, 2 youth staff and 1 Upham Woods staff member, who together will serve as chaperones, role models, and activity directors for camp. All of the adult volunteers are enrolled 4-H leaders and have completed the youth protection process. All youth staff, ranging from age 15-19, have participated in training as well. Our ratio of campers to staff is 4 to 1.
