Older Youth Travel Experiences, Awards & Scholarships OVERVIEW OF OPPORTUNITIES

4-H TRAVEL EXPERIENCES

TRAVEL FEES, FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE & SCHOLARSHIPS – Youth registered for a 4-H Travel Experience must pay the full cost of the trip in advance of the experience. Youth selected for a 4-H Trip Scholarship through the application and interview process will be eligible for reimbursement for 2/3 of the trip costs after fulfilling post-trip requirements of both the 4-H Adult Leaders and 4-H Junior Leaders. Pre-trip financial assistance is available if the upfront cost of the trip is a financial barrier to participation. A youth approved for financial assistance will have 2/3 of the trip cost waived, as provided by the 4-H Adult Leaders and 4-H Junior Leaders.

National 4-H Conference – Washington, D.C.

Fall Application

When: April 6-12, 2018

Only six to eight (6-8) youth from Wisconsin are selected to attend this annual working conference held at the National 4-H Center. Each participant selects an issue and works with other youth from across the country to develop plans that help direct future 4-H programming. Delegates spend the majority of time contributing to stimulating, task-oriented groups. One day is spent on Capitol Hill meeting with legislators and touring. 4-H members must be in **10th-12th grade** at time of the program, a minimum age of 15 and a maximum age of 18 as of January 2018. The total cost for the trip is approx. \$1,300. The Wisconsin 4-H Foundation sponsors a portion of this trip.

Space Camp – Huntsville, Alabama

Fall Application

When: April 26-30, 2018

Delegates participate in hands-on mock space missions and other activities in this NASA program while exchanging ideas with youth from across Wisconsin: <http://fyi.uwex.edu/wi4hedopp/space-camp/>.

4-H members must be in **6th-8th grade** and a maximum age of 15 at the time of the trip. The total cost of Space Camp is approx. \$625.

Citizenship Washington Focus (CWF) - Washington, D.C.

Fall Application

When: 9 days; Choice of three week-long options – June 16-24, 2018; June 23-July 1, 2018; or July 7-15, 2018

This leadership program, held at the National 4-H Center, teaches the importance of civic and social responsibilities as they relate to the development of better citizens and leaders. 4-H members must be in **10th-12th grade** at time of selection and a minimum age of 15 during trip. The total cost for the trip is approx. \$1,400.

National 4-H Congress – Atlanta, Georgia

Fall Application

When: November 23-27, 2018

National 4-H Congress is the flagship event of the 4-H program; it provides youth with a quality educational and cross-cultural experience that exceeds what any state independently can provide. Delegates participate in self-development seminars, tours and a service project while exchanging ideas with youth from across the country. 4-H members must be in **10th-12th grade** at time of selection and a maximum age of 18 as of January 2018. The total cost for the trip is approx. \$1,200.

Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference – UW-Madison

Spring Application

When: June 25-28, 2018

This annual four-day conference gives 500+ youth from across Wisconsin a chance to come together to learn about a variety of 4-H and other youth programs. Participants experience hands-on learning in a university campus atmosphere, strengthen life skills such as communication and leadership, gain knowledge to share back home, and exchange ideas and form friendships with youth from around the state. 4-H members must be in **7th-10th grade** at time of selection. The registration cost for this trip is approx. \$250 (includes lodging and meals). Some optional seminars may cost extra.

4-H COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

4-H Adult Leaders Scholarship – *three \$500 scholarships available*

Spring Application

Applicants must be enrolled in Green County 4-H at the time of application, have been enrolled in Green County 4-H for at least three (3) years, and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college or technical school during the 2018-2019 academic school year. Applicants can be awarded this scholarship only once.

4-H Junior Leaders Scholarship - *three \$500 scholarships available*

Spring Application

Applicants must be enrolled in Green County 4-H at the time of application and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college or technical school during the 2018-2019 academic school year. Applicants must also have been active in the Junior Leaders organization for a minimum of one (1) year, with preference given to youth who have been active in Junior Leaders for three (3) or more years. Applicants can be awarded this scholarship only once.

Cindi Miller Memorial Scholarships – *two \$1,000 scholarships available*

Spring Application

Applicants must be enrolled in Green County 4-H at the time of application and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college or technical school during the 2018-2019 academic school year. A key criteria for selection of this scholarship is a high level of community involvement. Applicants can be awarded this scholarship only once.

4-H AWARDS

4-H Key Award

Spring Application

This award is the highest award a 4-H member can receive in Wisconsin 4-H. It recognizes members in 11th grade and older who have shown consistent growth in their 4-H program, developed their leadership ability, and been helpful to other members in their club and community. Youth must have completed at least three years of 4-H club membership and one year of youth leadership. A limit of only 3-4 members from Green County can be selected for this annual award.
